Hans-Christian Hagman, UD

Hans-Christian Hagman is Chief Analyst and Senior Adviser to the Swedish State Secretary for Foreign Affairs since 2014. Areas of responsibility include strategy, policy planning, foresight and long-term analysis at the Ministry. Previously he was head of the Office of Strategic Analysis in the Prime Minister's Office from 2012 to 2013, and head of the Strategic Analysis Unit in the Swedish Ministry of Defense from 2000 to 2011. He has also worked for the International Institute for Strategic Studies in London, the Swedish Military Intelligence, the UN, the Swedish Armed Forces HQ and a number of think tanks. He has a PhD in War Studies from King's College London, degrees from Georgetown University and Lund University, attended NATO Defense College Senior Course and is a Major in the reserves (Swedish Royal Marines). He has written and lectured widely on geostrategy, technology trends, European security, NATO, UN, China and asymmetric warfare.



Maria Uiff Möller, Ministry of Higher Education and Science

Maria Uiff-Møller is currently the Head of the International Relations Department at the Ministry of Higher Education and Science, where she also previously was the deputy head. Maria has experience from being a team leader for EU Cooperation at the Agency for Higher Education and Science, the Committee Clerk for the International Secretariat of the Danish Parliament, and desk officer at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. Maria has a MSc Political Science from University of Copenhagen.



Koen Verlaeckt, VLIR

Koen Verlaeckt is the Secretary General for the Flemish Interuniversity Council's secretariat since 2018. He has a PhD in archaeology from the University of Ghent and was active in archaeological research on the Bronze Age. In 1997 he joined the Flemish Science and Innovation administration, and in 2003 became the acting head of the Technology and Innovation Division. He has been a member of the European Framework Programme for Research and Development and was involved in preparing the Code of Conduct and the European Quality Charter for Researchers. In 2006 Koen Verlaeckt became Head of Cabinet of the Government of Flanders and a senior advisor for science and innovation policy. In 2008 he became the Secretary General of the Flanders Department of Foreign Affairs.
